- Have you worked on shows before? Show us some pictures or tell us about it.
- Do you like to draw pictures of costume designs? We would love to see them!
- Have you dressed up for Halloween or Comic Con in something you made all by yourself? Give us a glimpse!!
- Do you make models out of clay? Those are props, and we want to see your work! If you have a visual art piece, a diorama, pictures of costumes you/ve made, holiday decorations you've designed and put up to show, or any woodworking you have accomplished, we would love to see it. If you have a passion for design, we are looking for you!
